FDI and America by the Numbers

US No. 1 destination for FDI in the world


- ➢ 30% of total FDI in 2021
- > Total Value \$405 billion
- Total Stock of FDI in the US \$5 trillion
 - > 42% or \$2.1 trillion in manufacturing
- Fastest Growing Sectors Retail Trade, Real Estate, Leasing and IT
 - Manufacturing grew 43%
- Largest Sectors Chemicals, Computers/Electronics, Transport Equipment, Medical Equipment
- Top 3 Investors Japan (\$721 B), Germany (\$637 B), Canada (\$607 B)
 - > UK, Ireland, France, Netherlands and Switzerland
 - > Top 8 account for 75% of all FDI




Keys to attracting advanced ICT projects


- Access to specialized skills is the main driver of expansion and location decisions






Latin America: FDI Outflows 2017-2021 (bn US\$)

Latin America: FDI Outflows 2017-2021 (% of GDP)


Largest contributor by % of GDP: Chile





Colombia: FDI Outflows 2019-2022


Breakdown by most relevant sectors, compared to total dedicated to the United States

Breakdown by sector & jobs created






Brazil: FDI Outflows to the U.S. - by State








US investment into Canada - 2012-2022










FDI by capex – A two-way street






